

Highlights of the 122nd Session

The 122nd Annual Session of the Florida State Primitive Baptist Convention was held April 17-21, 2022, in Tallahassee at the Old West Enrichment Center. North Central Florida Primitive Baptist Association, Elder Michael T. Israel, Moderator, served as host.

The week opened on Monday evening with an elegant reception for all Conventioneers hosted by **Interim President Elder Dr. Chris A. Burney.**

The Old West Florida Association's Hospitality Committee, under the direction of **Mother Diane Johnson**, Committee Chairman served as host for the reception.

North Central Moderator Michael T. Israel, presided over the program that included Invocation by Vice Moderator Rodney T. Osborne; Blessing of the Food by Church School President Clem Robinson; and Remarks from each of the North Central



Auxiliary Presidents: Mothers and Deaconess – Mother Betty Battle, Ministers' Wives/Widows – Mother Lorraine Whitaker, Ushers – Brother John Ingram, Choir – Mother Corrine McNair, Laymen – Deacon George Simmons and Remarks by Elder Dr. Chris A. Burney.

After dining and fellowshipping, conventioneers moved upstairs to the sanctuary for the Opening Program. The Opening Program included greetings from several religious/government/community/school leaders; a sermon, "Testing" by Elder Willie L. Manning, Pastor at Spring Hill Missionary Baptist Church, Tallahassee, with song service by the Spring Hill Choir.

Throughout the week, there were inspiring, enriching, and motivating Church School classes, sermons, and discussions based on the theme, "Standing on His Promise" – Isaiah 41:10.

On Wednesday, each Women's Congress auxiliary hosted a special luncheon at various locations throughout the City. During the Lillian Brantley Scholarship Luncheon on Thursday, one \$1,000 scholarship was presented to Amaya Waymon, *a senior at Rickards High School, Tallahassee and member at Greater Mt. Zion Primitive Baptist Church, Tallahassee* (*Old West Florida*). Two former scholarship winners were speakers: Mr. Cyrus Calhoun, New Zion Primitive Baptist Church, Tallahassee; and Mr. Dexter Hogan, Mt. Pleasant Primitive Baptist Church, Tallahassee.

In lieu of Queen Contestants, each auxiliary was asked to make a contribution of at least \$500 to the Scholarship Fund. Donations were reported as follows: Ministers' Wives/Widows - \$962; Mothers/Deaconesses - \$875; Laymen - \$730; Women of the Church - \$600; Matrons - \$565; Choir - \$515.






